


## World Population Evolution





## **World Population Evolution**




## World per Capita GDP



    - All are destroyed during Korean War (1950–1953)




#### Important Question... and Wrong Answer

    - South Korea was under Dictatorship & Totalitarian Regime until early 1990's


#### Real Per Capita GDP in North and South Korea

(1990 International Dollars)




